

LARRY REINKEMEYER ASSISTANT INSPECTOR GENERAL FOR AUDITS AND EVALUATIONS US DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

Larry Reinkemeyer was appointed the Assistant Inspector General (AIG) for Audits and Evaluations in June 2016. As the AIG for Audits and Evaluations, he directs the Office of Inspector General's (OIG) national audit and evaluation program, encompassing a network of geographically dispersed field and headquarters staff.



He formulates audit policies, programs, plans, and special initiatives within the framework of relevant legislation, policy, regulations, budget, and administration.

Prior to his appointment as the AIG for Audits and Evaluations, he served nearly nine years as the Director of the OIG's Kansas City Audit Operations Division. Prior to joining the OIG in 2001, Mr. Reinkemeyer worked for 18 years in various capacities for the US Army Audit Agency and was stationed in St. Louis, Missouri; Frankfurt, Germany; Huntsville, Alabama; and Fort Monroe, Virginia.

Mr. Reinkemeyer is a certified public accountant and earned a bachelor of science in accounting from Lincoln University in Jefferson City, Missouri, followed by a master of public administration from Troy State University.
